

## Community Center Membership Information

### Memberships

1. A “**resident**” is defined as a person whose primary domicile is within the boundaries of Middleburg Hts. and can provide proof of residency.
2. An “**employee**” is defined as someone who is on the roster of an employer in Middleburg Hts. and works full time (at least 37 ½ + hours per week). Part-time is considered working anything less.
3. 2 proofs of residency or proof of employment must be shown at the time a new membership is purchased. Examples are a current utility bill, current insurance card, current credit card bill, current car registration, driver’s license (if it was renewed within the past year), rental agreement, current pay stub, etc. The front desk supervisor will make the final determination.
4. Reminders will be sent via postcard when memberships are about to expire. These may be used to prove residency for those renewing. If postcard is not used, renewals will require 1 proof of residency.
5. Program, class, activity & special event fees are not included in membership packages.

Memberships CAN be paid for by personal check, debit/credit card (Visa/Master Card), or cash. All transactions must be done in person – **NO** email, phone or mail-in correspondence will be accepted. All payments must be made in full. **NO** partial payments will be accepted. Memberships run for one calendar year from issuance date unless otherwise noted.

Anyone in the military who works or trains in the City of Middleburg Hts. can also use the center for FREE! Again, just show us proof! Recruiters or other military personnel may bring in a prospect to conduct physical testing for FREE!

\*Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years old & above to use the center (a student 15 years old and above may accompany a child in the pool).

\*\*A “**family**” is defined as 5 directly related individuals which includes a maximum of 2 adults and up to 3 children (or 1 adult and up to 4 children), stepchildren or foreign exchange students under the age of 19 who reside at the same domicile. Each child after the 5<sup>th</sup> family member who is over the age of 2 must pay an additional \$20 (\$30 for employee’s families). Extended relatives such as cousins, in-laws, etc. are NOT to be included in this package. The Recreation Director will make the final determination concerning eligibility and refunds.

## Community Center Membership Information, continued

### **Non-Resident Passes**

The following packages are available for those who do NOT reside in Middleburg Hts. or work full-time in the city. A limited # of passes will be sold. The recreation department will close sign-ups at its discretion.

Non-Resident Weekday-Only (under 60) <i>Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> – May 31<sup>st</sup> only</i>	<b>\$200/9 months</b>	<b>\$30/month</b>	<b>\$5/daily</b>
Non-Resident Weekday-Only (60+)	<b>\$200/yearly</b>	<b>\$20/month</b>	<b>\$3/daily</b>

Age is determined at the time of purchase. The two memberships listed above are valid ONLY between the hours of 6:00 am – 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Non-resident weekday-only passes for those under 60 are NOT valid on Holidays or during the months of June, July & August.

Student(s) MUST be 15 yrs. old & under, directly related to a resident member (e.g. grandchild, niece, nephew) and have a parent sign the waiver form. A limit of 2 non-resident relative student memberships may be purchased per resident member. The monthly & 9-month memberships are valid ONLY from September 1<sup>st</sup> through May 31<sup>st</sup>. The 3-month summer membership is valid ONLY from June 1<sup>st</sup> through August 31<sup>st</sup>.

## Admittance Policies

The Community Center has implemented the following stamp/wristband system to identify who is in the facility for your safety and protection:

- Black Date Stamp:** A non-member daily visitor who has paid a full guest pass admission will receive this ID. You will be permitted to go anywhere in the building with no time restrictions.
- Red Date Stamp:** This ID will be given to a person who purchases a non-resident membership which is valid from 6:00 am-4:00 pm, Monday-Friday, Sept. 1-May 31 ONLY. These pass holders are NOT entitled to member registration dates & fees.
- Green View Stamp:** Non-Paying daily visitors who have permission to view the pool or gym ONLY from the casual activities get this ID. They may also assist a child in the locker room, if needed. Birthday party guests who are not paid for will receive this stamp and are NOT permitted in the pool, gyms, exercise area or track.



- Smiley Face Stamp:** This ID is for participants in organized programs & classes in the building, but NOT in the pool. They must leave immediately after their program/class and cannot use the facility.
- Wristband:** Participants enrolled in organized swimming programs (eg. learn-to-swim & water exercise programs) receive this ID instead of a stamp. The wristband means that the participant is a non-member who is here for the program/class ONLY. The band is NOT to be removed by anyone until the completion of the program/class. You may NOT continue to swim or use the rest of the building after your program/class is completed.

The Tot Watch Staff also issues wristbands with corresponding numbers for each parent/guardian and child using this service. Children will ONLY be released to a parent/guardian that has a corresponding, NUMBERED wristband
